Criminal and legal responses to the challenges of martial law in Ukraine", which will take place on **May 5, 2022 from 13.00 to 18.00** in online format on the **Zoom** platform.

Indicative thematic areas of the event:

1. Peculiarities of criminal liability for criminal offenses committed during martial law;
2. Problems of qualification of criminal offenses against the foundations of national security of Ukraine, against the order of military service and against peace and security of mankind;
3. Novelization of the current criminal legislation under martial law: problems and prospects;
4. Stimulation by means of criminal law of positive socially active behavior of a person during martial law;
5. Criminal-legal mechanisms of protection of rights and freedoms of man and citizen, interests of society or state under conditions of aggressive war against Ukraine;
6. Perspectives of Ukraine's implementation of international law norms and reception of prescriptions of national legislation of foreign countries on responsibility for criminal offences against peace and security of mankind;
7. Issues of improvement of the provisions of the new Draft Criminal Code of Ukraine regarding liability for criminal offences committed during martial law.
