**Rhodes Model Regional Co-operation** or **RhodesMRC** is presenting its 13<sup>th</sup> version with two conferences for university students and graduates and for high school students respectively.

Being academically innovative, RhodesMRC has brought for the first time in its region simulations of the Union of the Mediterranean, the Black Sea Economic Co-operation, the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe, the League of Arab States, the Asia-Pacific Economic Co-operation or the Organization of American States, along with simulations of the EuroAtlantic Partnership Council or the North Atlantic Council of NATO and the Council of Europe. Before the pandemic, RhodesMRC was one of the largest youth leadership events in the world, targeting high school students, university undergraduates and graduates, young scientists and professionals, for the most satisfying conference experience, assuming the role of diplomats and simulating the proceedings of some of the most important regional International Governmental Organizations, in multiple fields like democracy and human rights, peace building, security, sustainable development, financial and economic cooperation, a.o.

The 13<sup>th</sup> RhodesMRC 2023 will take place in **Rhodes, Greece**, **October 18-22, 2023**, for the university edition – open to both students and graduates -, and **November 09-12, 2023**, for the high school level.















Students, young scientists of law, political science or international relations and diplomats, or just international relations "fans", gather together in Rhodes every year to simulate the works of the organs and committees of a series regional international organizations, gaining valuable experience on negotiations and resolution making, while specializing to demanding topics focused on specific regions of the planet.

## **University Edition**

RhodesMRC 2023 will be the 13th University Edition of the Rhodes Model Regional Co-operation and will include the simulations of:

- Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) (crisis)
- NATO's North Atlantic Council (NATO) (crisis)
- Council of Europe (CoE)
- African Union (AU)
- Council of the European Union (EU)
- Union for the Mediterranean (UfM)
- League of Arab States (LAS) (crisis)
- Organization of American States (OAS)
- Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD)
- Rhodes Judicial Conference on Human Rights (RJCHR)

With three of its committees running in crisis mode, the real challenge during RhodesMRC 2023 is to remain realistic; the crisis scenarios are inspired by real-life incidents, with realistic timetables and details that are within the limits of possibility. The overall goal of each committee is to achieve a peaceful solution to every challenge thrown at them, while fostering interconnection among committees, with new digital tools.

#### Fees

The fees are set to 90,00€ per person and include: the Participant's Kit, the Certificate, the Opening and Closing Ceremonies, incl. their receptions, all lunches and coffee breaks offered during sessions, as described in the official program. All fees are offered, on a fully prepaid, non-refundable basis.

#### Types of participation

- All adults, age 18-35, with advanced language skills in English are welcome to apply as delegates, staff members or observers.
- A delegate is assigned to a country and represents the country during the sessions.
- A staff member serves as an usher during sessions and is involved in the overall preparation of the conference. Staff members receive a full-fees waiver.
- An observer is an individual that can attend the proceedings, without any right to intervene in the
  procedure or interact with the board and delegates.
- Applicants younger than 18 or older than 35 may apply as observers or staff members.

#### Accommodation

The Organizing Committee of RhodesMRC partners with hotels within walking distance off the conference venues in order to secure low-cost quality accommodation for as low as 48 euros per double room per night, incl. breakfast, free Wi-Fi and all taxes.



Since 01/01/2018, an extra overnight tax is applied to all stays, which varies depending on the classification of the hotel. The extra overnight tax is not included at the hotel bill and room price and is charged and collected separately.
