

Compulsory Modules

- NLU students have one compulsory module:
- Law 4016_ONL Dissertation
 - o 10,000 word piece of independent legal research
 - o Completed during semester three, due in August 2023
 - Supervised by Edge Hill and NLU staff
 - Worth one third of the overall degree
 - EHU Library provides support to NLU students for research techniques, legal writing and referencing (OSCOLA).

Optional Modules

- Each module is worth c. 8% of the overall degree.
- Students choose four modules, run in semester two.

Assessments

There are three forms of assessments employed by the School of Law and Criminal Justice for online students:

- Time Limited Assessments
 - o Generally 24 hours.
 - Students given an exam and have 24 hours to complete it and upload the script to the VLE
- Presentations via online platform
 - Asynchronous students prepare presentations and upload them by the deadline to the VLE
- Coursework
 - Essay Question
 - o Can be 1,500, 2000 or 3,000 words
 - o Title given to students in advance
