- Second line: Name of the institution (Times New Roman, 14 pt, Italic);
- Third line (centered, in uppercase letters): Title of the abstract (Times New Roman, 14 pt, Bold);
- References (optional): Left-aligned, Times New Roman, 12 pt, Italic, formatted according to DSTU 8302:2015;
- In-text citations should be enclosed in square brackets, indicating the reference number and page(s), e.g., [5, p. 57-61].
